12The commission shall dissolve on September 30, 2021132025, unless continued by act of the Legislature.

14 Section 2. This act is curative and shall apply 15 retroactively to confirm the continued existence and 16 continuing authority of the Alabama Commission on Tick Borne 17 Illness to allocate funds for research on tick borne illness 18 in the state.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
