4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

- (a) This state acknowledges, declares, and affirms that it is the public policy of this state to recognize and support the sanctity of unborn life and the rights of unborn children, including the right to life.
- (b) This state further acknowledges, declares, and affirms that it is the public policy of this state to ensure the protection of the rights of the unborn child in all manners and measures lawful and appropriate.
- (c) Nothing in this constitution secures or protects a right to abortion or requires the funding of an abortion.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 1 2 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 3 following description of the substance or subject matter of 4 5 the proposed constitutional amendment: "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 6 7 Alabama of 1901, as amended; to declare and otherwise affirm 8 that it is the public policy of this state to recognize and 9 support the sanctity of unborn life and the rights of unborn 10 children, most importantly the right to life in all manners 11 and measures appropriate and lawful; and to provide that the 12 constitution of this state does not protect the right to 13 abortion or require the funding of abortion. 14 "Proposed by Act ." 15 This description shall be followed by the following
