8 MOURNING THE DEATH OF MR. LEMUEL GREENE BOYETT, II.

10 WHEREAS, with profound sorrow and regret, we receive
11 news of the death of Mr. Lemuel Greene Boyett, II, of
12 Sulligent, Alabama, on June 14, 2011, at the age of 59 years;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the untimely death of Mr. Boyett leaves a
15 void in the lives of his loving family, his many friends, and
16 the entire community, where he was well-known as an esteemed
17 pharmacist and a civic leader who volunteered many hours to
18 worthy causes; and

19 WHEREAS, born on October 14, 1951, in Lamar County,
20 Alabama, he was a 1970 graduate of Sulligent High School and
21 was a standout basketball player who was an All-State
22 selection; Mr. Boyett received a basketball scholarship to the
23 University of West Alabama, where he earned a Bachelor of
24 Science Degree in 1974, prior to being accepted into Pharmacy
25 School at Auburn University; he graduated in 1976 and later
26 received an honorary Doctorate of Pharmacy Degree; in 1978, he
27 opened Family Health Pharmacy in Sulligent; and

1 WHEREAS, he was a director of First State Bank for
2 38 years; among his many community contributions, he was an
3 active member of the Sulligent Kiwanis Club and was
4 instrumental in the building of the Sulligent Track and
5 Sulligent Elementary Gym; he also served as president of the
6 Sulligent Girls Booster Club for many years; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Boyett was a true man of faith and a
8 devout member of Sulligent First Baptist Church, where he
9 served as a deacon, taught Men's Sunday School and RA's for
10 many years, and served diligently on numerous committees
11 including the Building Committee that worked to develop the
12 Christian Life Center, which he envisioned as a tool for
13 ministering to the community; and

14 WHEREAS, among his well-deserved recognitions, he
15 was voted Kiwanian of the Year in 1991 and was inducted into
16 the Lamar County Sports Hall of Fame; and

17 WHEREAS, survivors include his wife, Janet Nolen
18 Boyett; his mother, Wilma Trimm Boyett; daughters, DeAnna
19 (Wesley) Woods, Lindsay (Michael) Broome, and Megan (Adam)
20 Heath; grandchildren, Tyler Shelton and Weston Boyett Woods
21 and Baby Girl Heath; sisters, Patsy Ashmore Guthrie, Myriam
22 (Michael) O'Mary; parents-in-law, Charles and Frances Nolen;
23 and brother-in-law; Mike (Cindy) Nolen; he was predeceased by
24 his father; Dennis Boyett; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Boyett was a valued member of the
26 community; although his presence will be greatly missed, his
27 memory will be cherished in the hearts and minds of those who

1 were fortunate to know him during the brief span of his
2 lifetime; now therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
4 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the untimely death of Mr.
5 Lemuel Greene Boyett, II, is recorded with deep sadness, and
6 this resolution is offered in tribute to his life, along with
