3 MOURNING THE DEATH OF MR. LEMUEL GREENE BOYETT, II.

5 WHEREAS, with profound sorrow and regret, we receive
6 news of the death of Mr. Lemuel Greene Boyett, II, of
7 Sulligent, Alabama, on June 14, 2011, at the age of 59 years;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the untimely death of Mr. Boyett leaves a
10 void in the lives of his loving family, his many friends, and
11 the entire community, where he was well-known as an esteemed
12 pharmacist and a civic leader who volunteered many hours to
13 worthy causes; and

14 WHEREAS, born on October 14, 1951, in Lamar County,
15 Alabama, he was a 1970 graduate of Sulligent High School and
16 was a standout basketball player who was an All-State
17 selection; Mr. Boyett received a basketball scholarship to the
18 University of West Alabama, where he earned a Bachelor of
19 Science Degree in 1974, prior to being accepted into Pharmacy
20 School at Auburn University; he graduated in 1976 and later
21 received an honorary Doctorate of Pharmacy Degree; in 1978, he
22 opened Family Health Pharmacy in Sulligent; and

23 WHEREAS, he was a director of First State Bank for
24 38 years; among his many community contributions, he was an
25 active member of the Sulligent Kiwanis Club and was

1 instrumental in the building of the Sulligent Track and
2 Sulligent Elementary Gym; he also served as president of the
3 Sulligent Girls Booster Club for many years; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Boyett was a true man of faith and a
5 devout member of Sulligent First Baptist Church, where he
6 served as a deacon, taught Men's Sunday School and RA's for
7 many years, and served diligently on numerous committees
8 including the Building Committee that worked to develop the
9 Christian Life Center, which he envisioned as a tool for
10 ministering to the community; and

11 WHEREAS, among his well-deserved recognitions, he
12 was voted Kiwanian of the Year in 1991 and was inducted into
13 the Lamar County Sports Hall of Fame; and

14 WHEREAS, survivors include his wife, Janet Nolen
15 Boyett; his mother, Wilma Trimm Boyett; daughters, DeAnna
16 (Wesley) Woods, Lindsay (Michael) Broome, and Megan (Adam)
17 Heath; grandchildren, Tyler Shelton and Weston Boyett Woods
18 and Baby Girl Heath; sisters, Patsy Ashmore Guthrie, Myriam
19 (Michael) O'Mary; parents-in-law, Charles and Frances Nolen;
20 and brother-in-law; Mike (Cindy) Nolen; he was predeceased by
21 his father; Dennis Boyett; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Boyett was a valued member of the
23 community; although his presence will be greatly missed, his
24 memory will be cherished in the hearts and minds of those who

1 were fortunate to know him during the brief span of his
2 lifetime; now therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
4 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the untimely death of Mr.
5 Lemuel Greene Boyett, II, is recorded with deep sadness, and
6 this resolution is offered in tribute to his life, along with
7 heartfelt sympathy to his grieving family.
