it is fitting to honor the memory of the participants in the
Tuskegee Syphilis Study; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we do hereby name that portion of Highway 81 in Macon County from mile marker 6 to mile marker 9 as the Tuskegee Syphilis Study Memorial Highway and request the appropriate officials to place and maintain signs or markers as provided in this resolution.
