5	WHEREAS, lifelong Alabamian Nimrod T. "Rod" Frazer		
6	has the utmost distinction of receiving the Silver Star for		
7	Gallantry in Action in the Korean Conflict and of building a		
8	lucrative career in finance and business; and		
9	WHEREAS, Rod Frazer is the son of William Frazer,		
10	one of 95,000 Alabamians who served in World War I as a member		
11	of the 167th Infantry Regiment, a unit of the 42nd "Rainbow"		
12	Division, which played a critical role in defending Paris and		
13	in breaking the German line during the Aisne-Marne Offensive;		
14	and		
15	WHEREAS, Rod Frazer has memorialized the		
16	achievements of the 167th Infantry Regiment and the Rainbow		
17	Division by providing for a ten-foot bronze sculpture of an		
18	American soldier carrying a dead comrade erected at the site		
19	of the Battle of Croix Rouge Farm; he established a foundation		
20	entrusted with the mission of erecting the Croix Rouge Farm		
21	Memorial and acquiring the property on which to build it; and		
22	WHEREAS, the 2011 dedication of the Croix Rouge Farm		
23	Memorial served as a celebration of goodwill between the		
24	people of France and Alabama; Frazer donated the memorial and		
25	property to the nearby city of Fere-en-Tardenois in 2012,

1 further increasing warm sentiments between France and Alabama;

WHEREAS, Rod Frazer further memorialized the service 3 4 of Alabamians in the 167th Infantry Regiment by authoring "Send the Alabamians: World War I Fighters in the Rainbow 5 6 Division"; published in 2014 by The University of Alabama Press, the book not only documented the achievements of the 7 8 167th Infantry Regiment, but reignited Alabamians' interest in 9 this important chapter of our history and reconnected many 10 Alabama towns with local heroes who had been forgotten; and

11 WHEREAS, in 2017, in recognition of the 100th 12 Anniversary of World War I, Rod Frazer will again memorialize 13 the service of the 167th Infantry Regiment through the 14 installation of an aviators' monument at Maxwell Air Force 15 Base and a second Rainbow Division monument at Union Station 16 in Montgomery; now therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 18 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby commend Nimrod T. 19 Frazer for his accomplishments in military service, business, 20 and scholarship and for keeping alive the memory of a 21 generation that gave valiantly to the cause of liberty.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That we express deep gratitude on behalf of the people of Alabama for his generous sponsorship of monuments placed in France and Montgomery in memory of American soldiers and aviators. HJR118
