WHEREAS, this procedure adversely impacts the WAPs mission to generate significant savings in energy costs for low-income households, particularly those having elderly persons, disabled persons, and families with children; and

WHEREAS, thousands of low-income households are struggling with extremely high energy bills as we are experiencing one of the coldest winters in recent memory
