3 MOURNING THE DEATH OF MR. JERRY L. COOPER.

5 WHEREAS, with profound sorrow and regret, we receive
6 news of the death of Mr. Jerry L. Cooper of Pinson, Alabama,
7 on October 8, 2011, at the age of 66 years; and

8 WHEREAS, the passing of Mr. Cooper leaves a void in
9 the lives of his loving family, his many friends, and the
10 entire community, where he was highly regarded; he was a
11 member of First Baptist Church of Double Springs; and

12 WHEREAS, born on November 22, 1944, in Mobile, he
13 was the son of Floyd and Dora Cooper; he served his country
14 with honor and distinction in the Army National Guard for 17
15 years and was employed as a welder for most of his days in the
16 workforce; in his spare time, he enjoyed fishing, hunting,
17 walks in the woods, and being outdoors; and

18 WHEREAS, in addition to his parents, he was
19 predeceased by his brother, Donald Smith, and sister, Shirley
20 Taylor; and

21 WHEREAS, survivors include his son, Jason Cooper;
22 daughter, Stephany Cooper (Hank) Moore; and grandchildren,
23 Jacob Riley Moore and Joshua Cooper Moore; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Cooper was a valued member of the
25 community; although his presence will be greatly missed, his

1 memory will be cherished in the hearts and minds of those who
2 were fortunate to know him; now therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
4 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the death of Mr. Jerry L.
5 Cooper is recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution is
