1 WHEREAS, without health care provider status, it 2 will continue to be difficult for a pharmacist to obtain 3 practice insurance for any area beyond filling prescriptions; 4 and

5 WHEREAS, Alabama has multiple under-served areas and 6 any contribution by the pharmacist in those areas will not be 7 allowed without the designation as a health care provider; now 8 therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 10 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Legislature supports the 11 designation of pharmacists as health care providers.
