pulled a handgun; Officer Hubbard drew his duty weapon, but before he could use it, the suspect shot multiple times, striking Officer Hubbard in the right forearm and right shoulder and grazing him with a bullet in the front of his neck; Officer Hubbard refused to go down and continued standing in the line of fire to maintain the suspect's focus on him and away from the customers; and

8 WHEREAS, without a moment's hesitation, Officer 9 Hubbard placed himself in the path of danger to protect the 10 public; Officer Hubbard disregarded his own safety and 11 retreated back to the main lobby of the store to warn the 12 customers and employees of the potential danger and advise 13 them to seek cover; and

14 WHEREAS, Officer Hubbard demonstrated immense 15 courage, diligence, and quick thinking in a highly dangerous 16 situation; his loyalty and unwavering commitment to protect 17 and serve the residents of Montgomery was evidenced though his 18 willingness to make the ultimate sacrifice to preserve lives; 19 and

20 WHEREAS, Officer Hubbard epitomizes the qualities of 21 those who serve and protect, and he is truly deserving of this 22 distinguished nomination for the Legislative Medal of Honor 23 for Law Enforcement; now therefore,
