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4 CREATING THE JOINT INTERIM LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON  
5 GAMING.

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7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
8 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Joint Interim Legislative  
9 Committee on Gaming is hereby created. The committee shall be  
10 composed of five members of each house, to be appointed by the  
11 presiding officer of each house. The membership of the  
12 committee shall be inclusive and reflect the racial, gender,  
13 geographic, urban and rural, and economic diversity of the  
14 state. The chair and vice chair of the committee shall be  
15 elected at the first meeting by the members of the committee.  
16 The committee shall study all facets of the status of the  
17 gaming industry in Alabama, including, but not limited to,  
18 electronic bingo. The committee may invite experts in the  
19 gaming field to address the committee and answer any questions  
20 that the members of the committee may have. ~~The committee~~  
21 ~~shall have subpoena power.~~

22 Upon the request of the chair, the Secretary of the  
23 Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall  
24 provide necessary clerical assistance for the work of the  
25 committee. Also, upon request of the chair, the Legislative  
26 Reference Service shall provide any research assistance

1 necessary for the work of the committee. The committee shall  
2 report its findings, conclusions, and recommendations to the  
3 Legislature not later than the fifth legislative day of the  
4 2011 Regular Session, whereupon the committee shall stand  
5 dissolved and discharged of any further duties and  
6 liabilities. Each member of the committee shall be entitled to  
7 his or her regular legislative compensation, his or her per  
8 diem, and travel expenses for each day he or she attends a  
9 meeting of the committee. Upon requisitions signed by the  
10 chair of the committee, these payments shall be paid out of  
11 any funds appropriated to the use of the Legislature by means  
12 of warrants drawn by the Comptroller on the State Treasury.  
13 Notwithstanding the foregoing, no member shall receive  
14 additional legislative compensation or per diem when the  
15 Legislature is in session or if a member is being paid any  
16 other payments on the same dates for attendance on other state  
17 business. The total expenditures of the committee shall not  
18 exceed \$5,000.
