8	RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CONTINUED AEROSPACE
9	MANUFACTURING GROWTH IN ALABAMA.

11	WHEREAS, the aerospace manufacturing sector in the
12	United States and the State of Alabama is creating significant
13	employment opportunities, business growth, and manufacturing
14	excellence, and is critical to the nation's military and
15	economic security; and
16	WHEREAS, the expanding industrial operations of
17	Airbus, located at the Brookley Industrial Complex in Mobile
18	County, Alabama, which directly employs over 1,250 engineers
19	and production technicians, is essential to the continued
20	growth of the aerospace manufacturing sector in the State of
21	Alabama; and
22	WHEREAS, Airbus has been a vital member of our
23	State's business community for more than 15 years, with three
24	major facilities in the State; and
25	WHEREAS, the \$600 million Airbus A320 United States
26	manufacturing facility in Mobile County, which opened in 2015,

has delivered over 164 Alabama-made aircraft to United States airline customers to date; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, Airbus broke ground on a \$300 million A220 United States manufacturing facility in Mobile County that will assemble the newest Airbus aircraft, the A220, for United States airline customers, with deliveries to begin in 2020; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, Airbus announced a further \$40 million investment in new facilities needed to increase production to seven A320 aircraft per month by 2021; and

WHEREAS, Airbus continues to expand its manufacturing employment footprint to South Alabama by recently announcing a further 275 jobs to be added over the next year coupled with the hiring of more than 600 production technicians in 2019, which more than doubled the number of its employees in one year; and

WHEREAS, Airbus supports over 275,000 American jobs by spending approximately \$15 billion annually with hundreds of United States suppliers, including many in Alabama; and

WHEREAS, proposed tariffs on imported aircraft components and assemblies from Europe place at risk this significant industrial and employment growth in the City of Mobile, Mobile County, and South Alabama as well as Airbus' suppliers across the state; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Legislature of the State of Alabama does hereby fully support the continued

manufacturing operations of Airbus at the Brookley Industrial
Complex in Mobile County, Alabama, and does hereby urge the
President of the United States and the United States Trade
Representative to continue the current trade policy of not
applying tariffs on imported aerospace components and
assemblies from Europe, and thereby ensure the continued
growth of aerospace manufacturing in Alabama.
