3 SERVICE TO TUSKEGEE UNIVERSITY.

5 WHEREAS, with very special pleasure, Tuskegee 6 University's Ninth President, Charlotte P. Morris, who has 7 served the university faithfully for almost 40 years in 8 different capacities, is heartily commended for her long and 9 storied career; and

10 WHEREAS, during her tenure, she led the development 11 of the five-year strategic plan, which set the university's 12 direction and celebrated a very significant increase in 13 research grants awarded to the university, including some 14 focusing on health disparities for African Americans in 15 general and others targeting cancer in the Black community; 16 and

17 WHEREAS, Dr. Morris was born in Kosciusko, 18 Mississippi, and graduated from Jackson State University, 19 where she earned her Bachelor's Degree in Business Education; she subsequently earned a Master's Degree from 20 21 Delta State University, followed by a PhD in Education and 22 Business Management from Kansas State University; she has completed additional graduate-level coursework at the 23 24 Harvard University Graduate School of Education's Institute 25 for Educational Management, higher education administration 26 coursework at Southern Illinois University-Carbondale, and 27 summer institutes in curriculum development in higher 28 education; and

29 WHEREAS, she joined the Tuskegee Institute as a 30 faculty member of the now Andrew F. Brimmer College of Business and Information Science; in 1987, she began serving 31 32 as Executive Associate/Chief of Staff to the University 33 President and Secretary to the University's Board of Trustees, duties she faithfully performed for 23 years; 34 35 during the last eight years in that position, she also 36 served as the Director of the University's Title III Program and as Chair of the University's Convocations and Special 37 38 Events Committee; and

39 WHEREAS, Dr. Morris served as associate dean and 40 professor of management at Brimmer College until 2016, when 41 she was appointed as the college's interim dean; and

WHEREAS, throughout her career, she has been held in highest esteem and in 2010 and also in 2020 she served Tuskegee University as interim president; on August 1, 2021, she began her tenure as President of Tuskegee University; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Morris has earned widespread admiration and respect through the years for her tireless dedication and exceptional abilities; her record of excellence reflects immense credit not only to Tuskegee University, but upon the entire State of Alabama, and she is truly deserving of special recognition; now therefore,
