26 making application to Congress to call a convention to the 27 President of the United States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of
Representatives, each member of the Alabama Delegation to the
United States Congress, and to the presiding officers of each
of the legislative houses in each state.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this application shall 5 be considered as covering the same subject matter as the 6 7 applications from other states to Congress to call a convention to set a limit on the number of terms that a person 8 may be elected to the United States House of Representatives 9 10 and the United States Senate; and this application shall be 11 combined with the applications of other states for the purpose 12 of attaining the two-thirds of the states necessary to require 13 Congress to call a limited convention for the purpose of 14 setting term limits on the Members of Congress, but shall not 15 be combined with applications on any other subject.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds of the states have made applications on the same subject.
