12 WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we 13 recognize Sergeant Joe Cotner of the Mobile Police Department 14 as a nominee for the 2016 Alabama Legislative Medal of Honor 15 for Law Enforcement, Alabama's highest law enforcement award 16 for extraordinary courage in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2015, Sergeant Cotner was advised by a parent of unsafe conditions and potential abuse at Saving Youth Foundation, a residential treatment center; and

21 WHEREAS, Sergeant Cotner interviewed the parent and 22 her daughter, who had been removed from the facility, and 23 determined that more information was needed; he coordinated 24 with the Department of Human Resources and the Mobile County 25 Health Department to inspect the facility and interview some 26 of the children in residence; during this process, it was 27 discovered that the living conditions were unsanitary with 1 multiple code and food violations, the care was deficient to 2 the point of a systematic pattern of willful neglect and abuse 3 by the staff; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Sergeant Cotner's instincts to follow up and thoroughly investigate, 36 children were rescued and removed from the facility, three staff were charged with 24 counts of Aggravated Child Abuse, and the facility was closed; due to the action of Sergeant Cotner, associated residential treatment facilities in other states are being investigated for similar issues; and

11 WHEREAS, Sergeant Cotner demonstrated courage, 12 diligence, and responsibility in an adversarial situation; his 13 loyalty and unwavering commitment to protect and serve the 14 residents of Mobile were evidenced through his willingness to 15 take steps to insure these children were removed from a 16 situation that was unsafe, abusive, and potentially dangerous; 17 and

18 WHEREAS, Sergeant Joe Cotner epitomizes the 19 qualities of those who serve and protect, and he is truly 20 deserving of this distinguished nomination for the Legislative 21 Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby recognize and honor Sergeant Joe Cotner as a nominee for the 2016 Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement and direct that he receive a copy of this resolution as evidence of our admiration and esteem.
