13 and the Monday Morning Quarterback Club; and

14 WHEREAS, Representative Williams is a member of
15 Fullness Christian Fellowship and has two sons, Regan and
16 Jordan; and

18 tirelessly on behalf of the citizens of Alabama while serving
19 in the House of Representatives and all who have served with
20 him will always remember his dedication and inspiring service;
