5	WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the
6	death on January 2, 2018, of Mr. Rick Hall of Muscle Shoals,
7	Alabama, at the age of 85 years; and
8	WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of
9	his loving family, many friends, and the entire community,
10	where he was highly regarded; and
11	WHEREAS, born Roe Erister Hall in the Freedom Hills
12	community in Franklin County, Mr. Hall became a major player
13	in the recording industry in the 1960s; and
14	WHEREAS, Mr. Hall was the cofounder of Florence
15	Alabama Music Enterprises, or FAME Records, in Florence; he
16	took sole ownership of the publishing company in 1960 and
17	moved it to Muscle Shoals; and
18	WHEREAS, Mr. Hall produced music for prominent
19	artists including Wilson Picket, Aretha Franklin, Clarence
20	Carter, Etta James, Candi Staton, the Osmonds, Mac Davis, Paul
21	Anka, and Bobbie Gentry; and
22	WHEREAS, one of the centerpieces on his desk was a
23	photo of his high school agriculture teacher, Grover Morrow,
24	the father of Rep. Johnny Mack Morrow; on the photo Mr. Hall

1	wrote, "To the man who believed in me and my music when nobody		
2	did"; and		
3	WHEREAS, Morrow's father gave Hall his first musical		
4	instrument, a mandolin, which he played on many occasions on		
5	Mr. Morrow's front porch; and		
6	WHEREAS, he was preceded in death by his father,		
7	Herman Marcie Hall; mother, Dollie Hall Sanford; brothers,		
8	H.M. Hall, Terry Ray Hall, and James Melvin Hall; and sister,		
9	Wetha Wenoka McMurray; and		
10	WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved wife, Linda		
11	Hall; sons, G. Rick Hall (Cindy), Mark Hall (Jessica), and		
12	Rodney Hall; five grandchildren, Rebecca, Mary Elizabeth,
