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4 CREATING THE JOINT INTERIM LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON
5 THE EFFECTS OF TASERS ON STUDENTS.
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7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
8 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Joint Interim Legislative
9 Committee on the Effects of the Use of Tasers on Students is
10 created. The committee shall be composed of the following: Two
11 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the
12 Speaker of the House of Representatives; one member of the
13 Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;
14 one member of the Senate appointed by the Lieutenant Governor;
15 and one member appointed by the Governor. The membership of
16 the committee shall be inclusive and reflect the racial,
17 gender, geographic, urban and rural, and economic diversity of
18 the state. The committee shall annually report to the
19 Legislature by the second legislative day of each regular
20 session the extent to which it has complied with the diversity
21 provision of this act. The chair and vice chair of the
22 committee shall be elected at the first meeting by the members
23 of the committee. The committee shall study all facets of the
24 effects of taser guns on students in grades K-12.

25 Upon the request of the chair, the Secretary of the
26 Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall

1 provide necessary clerical assistance for the work of the
2 committee. The committee shall report its findings,
3 conclusions, and recommendations to the Legislature not later
4 than the fifth legislative day of the 2011 Regular Session.
5 Each member of the committee shall be entitled to his or her
6 regular legislative compensation, his or her per diem, and
7 travel expenses for each day he or she attends a meeting of
8 the committee. Upon requisitions signed by the chair of the
9 committee, these payments shall be paid out of any funds
10 appropriated to the use of the Legislature by means of
11 warrants drawn by the Comptroller on the State Treasury.
12 Notwithstanding the foregoing, no member shall receive
13 additional legislative compensation or per diem when the
14 Legislature is in session or if a member is being paid any
15 other payments on the same dates for attendance on other state
16 business. The Committee shall not meet more than six times.
17 The total expenditures of the committee shall not exceed
18 \$5,000.00.
