1991, serving as president in 2000-2001; he had served five
years on the Alabama Board of Examiners in Counseling; in
addition, he was a member of the Huntsville Hospital Ethics
Board and a longtime supporter of the Huntsville Symphony and
Young Life; and

6 WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his death a daughter, 7 Meredith Kramer Hay; son-in-law, John C. Hay, III; three 8 grandchildren; and a cousin, Mary Anne Kramer; and

9 WHEREAS, Reverend Kramer was a valued member of the 10 community whose presence will be greatly missed by all those 11 who were privileged to know him; now therefore,
