7 WHEREAS, the End Distracted Driving (EndDD) Student 8 Awareness Initiative was started by Joel Feldman, founder of 9 the Casey Feldman Memorial Foundation, in an effort to raise 10 awareness of the dangers of distracted driving and to 11 emphasize the importance of focusing full attention on driving 12 safely; and

WHEREAS, Joel Feldman has dedicated himself to this cause to honor the memory of his late daughter, Casey Feldman, a 21-year-old, award winning student journalist, who was a senior at Fordham University in New York City when she was killed by a distracted motorist on July 17, 2009; and

WHEREAS, distracted driving kills more than 5,000 people and injures nearly 450,000 more each year, yet, it received little public attention until EndDD actively targeted audiences, such as students, with its Student Awareness Initiative, geared to educate and inform drivers about the safety crisis related to distracted driving, its costs, implications, and often fatal consequences; and HJR372

WHEREAS, the Alabama Association for Justice's 1 2 attorney members are joining more than 850 attorneys, judges, 3 and safety advocates from the United States and Canada in pledging to give safety presentations on distracted driving to 4 5 local high schools, community groups, and civic organizations, with a goal to reach more than 100,000 drivers and potential 6 drivers each year, with the support of "60 for Safety," a 7 8 group of attorneys committed to increasing safety awareness to 9 prevent injuries or fatalities; and 10 WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature commends the 11 commitment and accomplishments of the EndDD awareness and educational campaigns initiated by Joel Feldman and his wife, 12 13 Diane Anderson, as well as the efforts by the Alabama 14 Association for Justice, to bring this campaign to our local 15 schools and communities, as we strive to make our roads safer 16 for drivers, passengers, and pedestrians; now therefore, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
