ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,
COMMENDING JESSE HOLLOWAY ON ATTAINING THE RANK OF
EAGLE SCOUT.

WHEREAS, Jesse Holloway has successfully completed
the requirements for the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest
honor in the Boy Scouts of America; and

WHEREAS, a member of Troop 134 in Springville,
Alabama, he is scheduled to receive special recognition and
his Eagle Scout award in a Court of Honor ceremony; and

WHEREAS, this coveted rank was earned through
countless hours of hard work, diligence, and great
perseverance to complete the required community service
project and to fulfill the additional stringent criteria for
Eagle Scout status; he has earned 28 Merit Badges while
serving in positions of leadership including Scribe, Assistant
Patrol Leader, and Patrol Leader; he received a scholarship to
attend the Boy Scout Adventure Camp, Florida Seabase, as well
as a number of Scouting awards; and

WHEREAS, his Eagle Scout project involved the Jack
Hanson Holloway Memorial Shade Garden at Big Springs Park in
Springville, where he led members of his troop in clearing an

10 attributes of self-discipline, self-reliance, good
11 citizenship, devotion to duty, and concern for his fellowman;

13 and his community, and he is truly deserving of this
14 significant honor; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
16 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Jesse Holloway is
17 congratulated and commended for his outstanding achievement of
