ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,
DESIGNATING A PORTION OF INTERSTATE 65 IN CHILTON
COUNTY AS DEDICATED TO ALABAMA'S CASUALTIES IN THE WAR ON
TERROR.

WHEREAS, this body honors various distinguished
Alabamians by naming portions of roadways and placing
commemorative signs in their honor; and

WHEREAS, these Alabamians come from all walks of
life, hold a multitude of jobs, and have a variety of reasons
that they were deserving of the honor; and

WHEREAS, every citizen of Alabama and the country
owes a great debt of gratitude to the brave and patriotic men
and women who are killed or wounded in service to their
country in times of great need; and

WHEREAS, it is both appropriate and desirable to
honor this group of individuals who have made the lives of
their fellow citizens better and have brought honor and
respect to the state and nation through their service and
sacrifice; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the portion of Interstate 65
located in Chilton County, Alabama, between the exit at mile
marker 212 and the exit at mile marker 219, shall be

1 designated as "Dedicated to Alabama's Casualties in the War on
2 Terror."

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
4 officials are requested to place and maintain a sign so
5 identifying the highway at or near mile marker 214.
