| 9  | Council. The primary purpose of the advisory council shall be |
| 10 | to identify successful methods and strategies to reduce the   |
| 11 | number of individuals driving under the influence and, in     |
| 12 | turn, alcohol-related fatalities in this state. To accomplish |
| 13 | this purpose, the advisory council shall conduct an in-depth  |
| 14 | analysis of pertinent laws, rules, and regulations in this    |
| 15 | state relating to driving under the influence and ignition    |
| 16 | interlocks and provide suggested modifications to enhance     |
| 17 | these laws, rules, and regulations.                           |
| 18 | The members of the advisory council shall include             |
| 19 | the following: A member of the House of Representatives       |
| 20 | appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; a   |
| 21 | member of the House of Representatives with a law enforcement |
| 22 | background appointed by the Speaker Pro Tempore of the House  |
| 23 | of Representatives; a member of the Senate appointed by the   |
| 24 | Senate President Pro Tempore; a member of the Senate with a   |
| 25 | legal background appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; a      |

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member appointed by the Governor; the Chair of the House 1 2 Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee, or his or her 3 designee from the committee; the Chairman of the Senate Judiciary Committee, or his or her designee from the 4 5 committee; the Director of the Administrative Office of 6 Courts, or his or her designee; the Director of the Department of Public Safety or his or her designee; the Chief of the 7 8 Department of Public Safety Drivers License Division, or his 9 or her designee; the Director of the Department of Forensic 10 Sciences, or his or her designee; the Office of Prosecution Services Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor, or his or her 11 designee; the President of the Alabama Circuit Judges 12 13 Association, or his or her designee; the Commissioner of the 14 Department of Mental Health, or his or her designee; a member 15 appointed by the Court Referral Officer Association of 16 Alabama; a member appointed by Mothers Against Drunk Driving 17 Alabama; the Chief of the Law Enforcement and Traffic Division 18 of ADECA, or his or her designee; a member appointed by the Alabama Criminal Defense Lawyers Association; the President of 19 the Alabama Association of Chiefs of Police, or his or her 20 21 designee; the President of the Alabama Sheriffs' Association, 22 or his or her designee; and a member appointed from each 23 approved ignition interlock provider according to the 24 Department of Forensic Sciences. The membership of the advisory council shall be inclusive and reflect the racial, 25

1 gender, geographic, urban/rural, and economic diversity of the 2 state.

3 The first meeting of the advisory council shall be held within 180 days of the effective date of this act. The 4 5 advisory council shall elect a chair from its membership at its first meeting and shall hold, at a minimum, one annual 6 meeting. The chair shall schedule additional meetings as he or 7 8 she deems necessary. The council may hold public meetings as necessary for the purpose of receiving input from the public 9 10 relating to the effectiveness of current driving under the 11 influence and ignition interlock laws, rules, and regulations.

12 All meetings of the advisory council shall be open 13 to the public. All findings, conclusions, and recommendations 14 for improvement of current driving under the influence laws, 15 rules, and regulations, if any, of the advisory council shall 16 be reported to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the 17 Speaker of the House of Representatives. The report shall also 18 be made available to the public.
