3 DESIGNATING THE SARALAND SECTION OF U.S. HIGHWAY 43  
4 AS "KEN WILLIAMS BOULEVARD."

6 WHEREAS, the City of Saraland suffered a great loss  
7 with the passing of Mayor Ken Williams on December 27, 2010;  
8 and

9 WHEREAS, Ken Williams served with distinction as a  
10 city councilman for four years and as mayor for 14 years; and

11 WHEREAS, Mayor Williams was the longest serving  
12 mayor in the City of Saraland; and

13 WHEREAS, during his tenure as mayor for the City of  
14 Saraland, Mayor Williams' service and efforts on behalf of the  
15 city were invaluable to the growth of Saraland and the  
16 preservation and maintenance of the city's charm; and

17 WHEREAS, U.S. Highway 43 runs through the heart of  
18 the City of Saraland and is well traveled by citizens and  
19 visitors; and

20 WHEREAS, the city, through its mayor and the city  
21 council, believes it would be a fitting memorialization of  
22 Mayor Williams' contributions to the City of Saraland for the  
23 Alabama Legislature to designate the section of U.S. Highway  
24 43 that runs through Saraland, Alabama, as "Ken Williams  
25 Boulevard"; now therefore,

1                   BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
2   HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the section of U.S. Highway 43  
3   that runs through Saraland, Alabama, be named "Ken Williams  
4   Boulevard" and that proper officials are requested to place  
5   and maintain markers designating "Ken Williams Boulevard" as  
6   provided in this resolution.
