RECOGNIZING L. O. BISHOP ON HIS INDUCTION INTO THE
2017 AUBURN UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION HALL OF
HONOR.

WHEREAS, it is a tremendous privilege to recognize
L. O. Bishop on his outstanding achievement of being named the
winner of the Production Award and being inducted into the
2017 Auburn University Agricultural Alumni Association Hall of
Honor; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Bishop, a native of Cherokee, Alabama,
grew up helping on his parents' farm; he now farms more than
500 acres of timber and row crops, rotating wheat, soybeans,
and corn; he has also raised hogs, selling more than 4,000
market hogs annually during his peak years; and

WHEREAS, in 1966, Mr. Bishop and his wife, Grace,
were selected by the Alabama Farm Bureau as Young Farm Family
of the Year; the Bishops have three children and six
grandchildren; Mr. Bishop continues to serve tirelessly as an
ambassador of agriculture; and

WHEREAS, agriculture service appointments for Mr.
Bishop include Alabama Farmers Federation District I Director
for over 13 years, North Area Vice President for 14 years, and
Colbert County President for over 40 years; in 1977, the

1 Alabama Cooperative Extension System presented Mr. Bishop with
2 the Agricultural Leadership Award; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Bishop was named one of the Shoals
4 area's top 10 leaders in 1986 by the Times Daily newspaper,
5 and in 1988, was named the Shoals Citizen of the Year by the
6 Shoals Chamber of Commerce; in 2013, the Alabama Farmers
7 Federation recognized Mr. Bishop with the highest honor given
8 by the organization, the Service to Agriculture Award; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Bishop has cultivated an indelible
10 legacy of excellence that is an enormous source of credit to
11 the agricultural industry and the entire State of Alabama; now
12 therefore,

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
14 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That L. O. Bishop is honored and
15 commended, and it is directed that a copy of this resolution
