ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,
AMENDING ACT 2019-84, HJR91 CONCERNING THE NAMING OF
PORTIONS OF INTERSTATE 20/59 IN JEFFERSON COUNTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Act 2019-84, HJR91, 2019
Regular Session, is amended to read as follows:

WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we
name the Tallapoosa Interchange in Jefferson County the
Sergeant Wytasha L. Carter Memorial Highway; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Carter, who served with the
Birmingham Police Department, was killed in the line of duty
on January 13, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Carter served in the United States
Air Force and the Leeds Police Department before joining the
Birmingham Police Department in 2011; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting to honor the memory of
Sergeant Wytasha L. Carter by naming a portion of an
interstate highway in Jefferson County in recognition of the
service and unselfish sacrifice of this Alabamian; now
therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we do hereby name the
Tallapoosa Interchange in Jefferson County as the Sergeant

1 Wytasha L. Carter Memorial Highway and request the appropriate
2 officials to place and maintain signs or markers as provided
3 in this resolution.
