4 ON THURSDAY, APRIL 1, 2010, AND COMMENDING DELTA SIGMA THETA

7 WHEREAS, it is with great pleasure that we recognize  
8 Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, on the observance of  
9 Delta Day, Thursday, April 1, 2010, at the Alabama State  
10 Capitol; and

11 WHEREAS, a sisterhood founded on January 13, 1913,  
12 by 22 collegiate women at Howard University, Delta Sigma Theta  
13 Sorority now has grown to a membership of more than 250,000  
14 women, predominantly Black and college-educated, in more than  
15 960 chapters throughout the United States and abroad; and

16 WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority follows a  
17 national Five Point Program: Economic Development, Educational  
18 Development, International Awareness and Involvement, Physical  
19 and Mental Health, and Political Awareness and Involvement;  
20 the sorority promotes academic excellence, provides

23 Delta Sigma Theta Sorority members who serve in the Alabama  
24 Legislature: Senator Linda Coleman and former Senator Sundra

2 President; and the late national Congresswomen of distinction,  
3 Shirley Chisholm, Barbara Jordan, and Stephanie Tubbs Jones;  
4 and Dr. Regina Benjamin, an Alabama native nominated on July  
5 13, 2009, to serve as the United States Surgeon General, who  
6 was unanimously confirmed by the United States Senate on  
7 October 29, 2009; and Reverend Gwendolyn E. Boyd, 22nd
