11	WHEREAS, the Joint Legislative Task Force on Budget

19	General Fund and the existing structure of the state budgeting

21	WHEREAS, due to the diligent work of task force
22	members, the task force has made significant progress in
23	formulating suggested policy changes to the budgeting process
24	which will facilitate thorough review and oversight of state
25	agency spending and ensure that taxpayer dollars are

WHEREAS, task force members should be commended for their efforts to formulate meaningful budget reform and should be afforded additional time to complete their research and finalize recommendations to the Legislature; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That, with appreciation, the members of the Joint Legislative Task Force are hereby commended for their diligent service to this state through their efforts to reform the budget process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, subdivision (2) of subsection (c) of Act 2016-480, HJR 62, 2016 First Special Session, relating to the Joint Legislative Task Force on Budget Reform, is amended to read as follows:

"(2) The task force shall meet monthly and shall report its findings, conclusions, and recommendations to the Legislature not later than the fifth legislative day of the 2018 Regular Session, whereupon the task force shall stand dissolved and discharged of any further duties and liabilities."
