8 EXTENDING THE LIFE OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR'S  
9 COMMISSION ON PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP PROJECTS, APPROVING  
10 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMISSION, AND LIMITING EXPENDITURES.

12 WHEREAS, on May 18, 2008, the Legislature of the  
13 Great State of Alabama, with both houses thereof in agreement,  
14 established the Lieutenant Governor's Commission on  
15 Public-Private Partnership Projects, SJR 119, Act No.  
16 2008-478. The commission was established to study  
17 public-private partnership projects in other jurisdictions and  
18 their potential application within Alabama, and to report its  
19 findings, conclusions, and recommendations for proposed  
20 legislation to the Legislature no later than the fifth  
21 legislative day of the 2009 Regular Session, whereupon the  
22 commission would stand dissolved and discharged of any further  
23 duties and liabilities; and

24 WHEREAS, the leadership of the commission in  
25 accordance with the recommendations contained in the 2009  
26 commission report did meet with persons deemed to have  
27 expertise and experience in P-3 surface infrastructure project

1 initiatives in both the domestic and international markets;  
2 and

3 WHEREAS, the commission leadership feels it is in  
4 the best interest of the commission objectives to conduct  
5 informational briefings by experienced P-3 experts to the  
6 commission at large as well as other relevant persons  
7 including interested members of the Alabama Legislature; now  
8 therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
10 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Lieutenant Governor's  
11 Commission on Public-Private Partnership Projects continue  
12 with implementation of the recommendations included in its  
13 original report to the Legislature and that the commission be  
14 extended until the fifth legislative day of the 2011 Regular  
15 Session of the Alabama Legislature.
