6 WHEREAS, it is a pleasure to extend highest
7 commendation to an outstanding Alabamian, Mr. Willie Maise of
8 Gadsden, in recognition of his achievements and dedicated
9 public service during a 37-year career with the Alabama Power
10 Company; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Maise has announced his retirement
12 effective April 30, 2010, from his position as Eastern
13 Division Mountainview Area Manager of Alabama Power Company;
14 through the years he has also been a prominent and influential
15 leader in the civic life of Gadsden and Etowah County; and

17 affiliations includes: the Downtown Gadsden Board, the

23 many additional worthy causes; it has been said of Mr. Maise

3 WHEREAS, in addition to his support of business and
4 industry, he has been a mainstay in efforts to enhance the
5 quality of life in the area, including the Cultural Arts
6 Board, the Etowah County Historical Society, Riverfest, and
7 the Keep Etowah Beautiful Executive Committee, along with the
8 Renew Our Rivers initiative; and

9 WHEREAS, a man of keen intellect, he has been a
10 lifelong learner, earning a law degree along the way that has
11 served him well in both his career and civic involvement; his
12 contributions to his fellowman are far-reaching and
13 innumerable, and over the span of almost four decades, he has
14 had a positive impact on many lives; Mr. Maise will be greatly
15 missed by colleagues in the workplace, but he will remain an
16 integral part of the life of his beloved city; now therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
18 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Mr. Willie Maise is honored
19 and commended for his outstanding achievements and dedicated
20 service, and this resolution is offered in highest tribute to
