WHEREAS, World Spay Day, celebrated on the fourth Tuesday of February each year, encourages people to have animals spayed or neutered as a way to prevent free-roaming animals from being put down in a facility or killed on the street; and

WHEREAS, free-roaming cats that are not spayed or neutered face many challenges; through the use of the non-lethal trap-neuter return (TNR) strategy, the number of cats is reduced, which means that euthanasia does not have to be used to control the population of cats; TNR programs evaluate, vaccinate, and sterilize cats before returning them to their locations, and some of the cats are offered for adoption; furthermore, TNR programs have been in existence in Alabama for many years and are often run by volunteers and nonprofit organizations; and

WHEREAS, the TNR program is highly effective, and several communities in Alabama have implemented the strategy through the Safe Harbor Animal Coalition; now therefore,
