3 COMMENDING JEFFREY LYNN TODD ON ATTAINING THE RANK
4 OF EAGLE SCOUT IN THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA.

6 WHEREAS, commendations and congratulations are
7 extended to Jeffrey Lynn Todd of Boaz, Alabama, on attaining
8 the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest rank in the Boy Scouts of
9 America; and

10 WHEREAS, the Eagle Scout Award, earned by only a
11 small percentage of Scouts, involves the completion of an
12 Eagle Project and represents many years of diligence in
13 pursuit of a worthy goal that brings honor to the Scout, his
14 family, and his troop; and

15 WHEREAS, having appeared before the Eagle Scout
16 Board of Review and found worthy of the rank of Eagle Scout,
17 Jeffrey will receive the award in a special Court of Honor
18 ceremony; and

19 WHEREAS, a member of Troop 50 of the Greater Alabama
20 Council, Jeffrey has progressed through the levels of Scouting
21 from Tiger Scout to Cub Scout to Eagle Scout, meeting the
22 demanding requirements for achieving this coveted award while
23 holding many positions of leadership; in addition to
24 completing an Eagle Project, an Eagle Scout must earn many
25 Merit Badges as evidence of mastery in various Scouting

1 skills, and must strive to conduct himself with honor,
2 loyalty, courage, cheer, and service, the five integral
3 responsibilities of a Scout; and

4 WHEREAS, Jeffrey's Eagle Scout project involved
5 providing enhancements to an existing Outdoor Classroom that
6 is located on the campus of West End High School and is used
7 by the Science and Agriculture Departments; he acquired
8 landscaping supplies, plants, and lumber to create 12
9 birdhouses; and

10 WHEREAS, Jeffrey is also an outstanding student who
11 participates in extracurricular activities and has devoted
12 many volunteer hours to worthy community projects; and

13 WHEREAS, through the years Jeffrey has exhibited
14 those hard-won characteristics of trustworthiness,
15 self-discipline, and good citizenship, all components of the
16 Scouting program; with the guidance and support of his
17 Scouting leaders, he has earned the esteem of his community,
18 fellow Scouts, and all Alabamians; now therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
20 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of his
21 outstanding achievement in attaining the prestigious rank of
22 Eagle Scout, Jeffrey Lynn Todd is highly commended, and this
23 resolution is offered in tribute to him along with best wishes
24 in all his future endeavors.
