2 ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,  
3 ESTABLISHING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE TO STUDY  
4 MUNICIPAL POLICE JURISDICTION LAWS.  
5

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
7 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That there is established the Joint  
8 Interim Committee To Study Municipal Police Jurisdiction Laws.

9 (a) The committee shall be composed of the following  
10 members:

11 (1) Six members of the Alabama Senate. The President  
12 Pro Tempore shall select three Senate members and the  
13 Lieutenant Governor shall select three Senate members.

14 (2) Six members of the House of Representatives  
15 selected by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

16 (b) The committee shall study Alabama laws relating  
17 to the police jurisdiction of municipalities and make  
18 suggestions for the improvement of these laws.

19 (c) The committee membership shall be inclusive and  
20 shall reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban, rural,  
21 and economic diversity of the state.

22 (d) The committee shall be charged with the  
23 following duties and responsibilities:

24 (1) Upon adjournment of this session of the  
25 Legislature, the committee shall schedule an initial meeting

1 to organize and discuss a plan of action and shall meet as  
2 necessary thereafter to achieve its goals.

3 (2) The committee shall report its findings and any  
4 proposed legislation to the Speaker of the House and President  
5 Pro Tempore of the Senate on the first day of the 2016 Regular  
6 Session, whereupon it shall stand dissolved and discharged of  
7 any further duty or liability.

8 (e) Upon request of the chair of the committee, the  
9 Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House of  
10 Representatives shall provide necessary clerical assistance  
11 for the work of the committee.

12 (f) Members of the committee shall receive their  
13 regular legislative compensation, per diem, and travel  
14 expenses for each day he or she attends a meeting of the  
15 committee in accordance with Amendment 871 of the Constitution  
16 of Alabama of 1901, subject to this subsection. These payments  
17 shall be paid out of any funds appropriated to the use of the  
18 Legislature. Total expenditures of the committee shall not  
19 exceed \$2,500.
