8 DESIGNATING THE PORTION OF INTERSTATE 65 NORTH
9 BETWEEN MILE MARKERS 263 AND 264 AS THE OFFICER JOSEPH JEROME
10 DANIELS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

12 WHEREAS, on November 18, 2002, Officer Joseph Jerome
13 Daniels of the City of Birmingham Police Department was killed
14 while attempting to stop a robbery at a local restaurant while
15 off duty; and

16 WHEREAS, Officer Daniels had been with the
17 Birmingham Police Department for 10 years at the time of his
18 death; and

19 WHEREAS, the bravery, devotion to duty, and love of
20 community of this fallen hero have forever earned him a place
21 in the hearts and memories of the citizens he willingly risked
22 his life to protect, an honor that comes at enormous cost to
23 the people who knew him best, loved him most, and remember him
24 as a father, as a relative, and friend; and

25 WHEREAS, it is altogether fitting and proper that we
26 remember and honor Officer Daniels; now therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
2 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the portion of Interstate
3 Highway 65 North between mile markers 263 and 264 be
4 designated as the Officer Joseph Jerome Daniels Memorial
5 Highway in honor of his service and sacrifice to our state and
6 the City of Birmingham.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
8 officials are requested to place and maintain signs or markers
9 as provided in this resolution.
