4 BETWEEN MILE MARKERS 263 AND 264 AS THE OFFICER JOSEPH JEROME
5 DANIELS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

7 WHEREAS, on November 18, 2002, Officer Joseph Jerome
8 Daniels of the City of Birmingham Police Department was killed
9 while attempting to stop a robbery at a local restaurant while
10 off duty; and

11 WHEREAS, Officer Daniels had been with the
12 Birmingham Police Department for 10 years at the time of his
13 death; and

14 WHEREAS, the bravery, devotion to duty, and love of
15 community of this fallen hero have forever earned him a place
16 in the hearts and memories of the citizens he willingly risked
17 his life to protect, an honor that comes at enormous cost to
18 the people who knew him best, loved him most, and remember him
19 as a father, as a relative, and friend; and

20 WHEREAS, it is altogether fitting and proper that we
21 remember and honor Officer Daniels; now therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
23 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the portion of Interstate
24 Highway 65 North between mile markers 263 and 264 be
25 designated as the Officer Joseph Jerome Daniels Memorial

1 Highway in honor of his service and sacrifice to our state and
2 the City of Birmingham.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
4 officials are requested to place and maintain signs or markers
5 as provided in this resolution.
