3 RECOGNIZING COPS' "FLY THE BLUE" CAMPAIGN.

5 WHEREAS, Concerns of Police Survivors (COPS) is an
6 organization dedicated to helping the survivors of America's
7 fallen law enforcement officers rebuild their lives through
8 hands-on programs based on strong peer support; and

9 WHEREAS, officers killed in the line of duty leave
10 behind families scarred by tragedy and in need of assistance
11 from organizations such as COPS; there can be no higher duty
12 than to honor and assist these families, whose husbands,
13 wives, sons, daughters, brothers, and sisters have given their
14 lives for the public good; and

15 WHEREAS, COPS provides resources to assist in these
16 families' efforts to rebuild their lives; COPS further
17 provides training to law enforcement agencies on survivor
18 victimization issues and educates the public about the need to
19 support the law enforcement profession and its survivors; and

20 WHEREAS, COPS provides a variety of programs for
21 survivors, including summer camps, scholarships, parents'
22 retreats, conferences, wilderness experiences, surviving
23 spouses' getaways, siblings' retreats, and adult children's
24 retreats; and

1 WHEREAS, COPS has initiated its "Fly the Blue"
2 Campaign, asking that every state, county, and city vehicle
3 fly a blue ribbon during the week of May 9 to May 15, 2010;
4 May 9 to May 15 is National Police Week; now therefore,

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
6 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That COPS' "Fly the Blue" Campaign
7 is recognized and that, with highest tribute, we offer this
8 resolution in appreciation of the efforts of Concerns of
9 Police Survivors to assist America's law enforcement
