CREATING THE TWO-YEAR COLLEGE SYSTEM JOINT INTERIM
LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Two-Year College System

Joint Interim Legislative Committee is created. The committee shall be composed of five members of each house, to be appointed by the presiding officer of each house. The membership of the committee shall be inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban and rural, and economic diversity of the state. The chair and vice chair of the committee shall be elected at the first meeting by the members of the committee. The committee shall study all facets of the two-year college system and shall adopt the recommendations of the Final Report of the House of Representatives Interim Legislative Study Committee To Assess The Two-year College System, submitted to the Alabama State Legislature on January 21, 2010.

Upon the request of the chair, the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall provide necessary clerical assistance for the work of the committee. The committee shall report its findings, conclusions, and recommendations to the Legislature not later

than the fifth legislative day of the 2011 Regular Session, whereupon the committee shall stand dissolved and discharged of any further duties and liabilities. Each member of the committee shall be entitled to his or her regular legislative compensation, his or her per diem, and travel expenses for each day he or she attends a meeting of the committee. Upon requisitions signed by the chair of the committee, these payments shall be paid out of any funds appropriated to the use of the Legislature by means of warrants drawn by the Comptroller on the State Treasury. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no member shall receive additional legislative compensation or per diem when the Legislature is in session or if a member is being paid any other payments on the same dates for attendance on other state business. The total expenditures of the committee shall not exceed \$5,000.
