2 ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,

3           CREATING THE TWO-YEAR COLLEGE SYSTEM JOINT INTERIM  
4 LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE.

6           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
7 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Two-Year College System  
8 Joint Interim Legislative Committee is created. The committee  
9 shall be composed of five members of each house, to be  
10 appointed by the presiding officer of each house. The  
11 membership of the committee shall be inclusive and reflect the  
12 racial, gender, geographic, urban and rural, and economic  
13 diversity of the state. The chair and vice chair of the  
14 committee shall be elected at the first meeting by the members  
15 of the committee. The committee shall study all facets of the  
16 two-year college system and shall adopt the recommendations of  
17 the Final Report of the House of Representatives Interim  
18 Legislative Study Committee To Assess The Two-year College  
19 System, submitted to the Alabama State Legislature on January  
20 21, 2010.

21           Upon the request of the chair, the Secretary of the  
22 Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall  
23 provide necessary clerical assistance for the work of the  
24 committee. The committee shall report its findings,  
25 conclusions, and recommendations to the Legislature not later

1 than the fifth legislative day of the 2011 Regular Session,  
2 whereupon the committee shall stand dissolved and discharged  
3 of any further duties and liabilities. Each member of the  
4 committee shall be entitled to his or her regular legislative  
5 compensation, his or her per diem, and travel expenses for  
6 each day he or she attends a meeting of the committee. Upon  
7 requisitions signed by the chair of the committee, these  
8 payments shall be paid out of any funds appropriated to the  
9 use of the Legislature by means of warrants drawn by the  
10 Comptroller on the State Treasury. Notwithstanding the  
11 foregoing, no member shall receive additional legislative  
12 compensation or per diem when the Legislature is in session or  
13 if a member is being paid any other payments on the same dates  
14 for attendance on other state business. The total expenditures  
15 of the committee shall not exceed \$5,000.
