BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 1 2 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we hereby urge the President and the Congress of the United States to expedite the decision 3 to construct the Keystone Oil Pipeline.
