19	WHEREAS, refusing to allow his disability to
20	interfere with a full and vibrant lifestyle, Ryan was active
21	in church, school, and social activities; he was a member of

24	retreats; he enjoyed volunteering at the Frazer welcome center
25	with his father, as well as assisting with the Youth Missions
26	Barbecue and helping to collect attendance notebooks for the

Children's Ministry; and

WHEREAS, under the auspices of the supportive
employment program at the Department of Mental Health, Ryan
held a part-time job delivering mail at the DMH central office
from 2005 until his passing on August 9, 2009; he bore the
distinction of being the first employee of a pilot project
focused on hiring individuals with significant disabilities;
and

WHEREAS, Ryan attended Brewbaker Elementary School and Jefferson Davis High School, where he participated in every facet of student life; and

WHEREAS, Ryan and his family were instrumental in the early stages of an advocacy movement that resulted in increased awareness and funding for Alabama's Early Intervention program and ultimately led to the inclusion of associated activities in Alabama public schools; and

WHEREAS, Ryan's passing is a great loss to his family and to the community; he left an indelible impression on everyone who knew and loved him over the 24 years of his remarkable and inspiring life; now therefore,
