27 Treasurer of the Rosinton Community Players in the 1950s; in

1 1954, she played the leading role in "The Night of January 2 Sixteenth" and appeared in many other productions; she was a 3 substitute teacher for the Baldwin County Board of Education 4 in the 1950s; she returned to college in the late 1960s to 5 study real estate; upon receiving her broker's license she 6 became the owner and broker of Cowling Realty in Robertsdale, 7 Alabama; and

WHEREAS, she and her husband hosted the first 8 9 American Field Service Exchange Student to Robertsdale High 10 School who was from Italy; beginning in 1973, Mrs. Cowling was appointed for 24 years, by the Governors of the State of 11 Alabama and the Alabama Commissioners of Agriculture and 12 13 Industries to the Baldwin County Board of Registrars; eight of 14 those years, she served as Chair of the Board; while working 15 at the Baldwin County Courthouse, she made many friends and enjoyed serving the citizens of Baldwin County; and 16

17 WHEREAS, Mrs. Cowling was a lifelong member of the 18 United Methodist Church, and served as a Sunday School teacher and assisted with many of the children's programs in her early 19 20 years; in the 1960s and 1970s, she served as a member of the 21 Pastor-Parrish Relations Committee at the Robertsdale United 22 Methodist Church and was a founding member of the New Life 23 Prayer Group; later she served as a member of the 24 Administrative Board of Rosinton United Methodist Church; and
