WHEREAS, his extensive research in poultry science contributed to a growing industry and was a major factor in making Alabama poultry a successful business; among his accomplishments, he designed his own chicken cages and also experimented with artificial light to stimulate egg production, a practice that is still being implemented; and WHEREAS, in his free time, Mr. King was an accomplished pianist, skilled crotchetier, and master woodcarver whose creations have been featured in the Woodcarvers Hall of Fame in Colorado; and

WHEREAS, through the years, Mr. King earned respect for his exceptional abilities and tireless dedication as he innovated, researched, and helped usher in the modern-day poultry industry as one of Alabama's most successful enterprises; now therefore,
