8	MOURNING THE DEATH OF DR. HAROLD A. FRANKLIN.

10	WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the
11	death on September 9, 2021, of Dr. Harold A. Franklin of
12	Talladega, Alabama, at the age of 88 years; and
13	WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of
14	his loving family, many friends, and the entire community,
15	where he was highly regarded; and
16	WHEREAS, Dr. Franklin was born on November 2, 1932,
17	to Mr. George Franklin and Mrs. Eugenia Williams Franklin in
18	Talladega, Alabama; he was the fourth of 10 children born to
19	this union; at an early age, he attended Mount Canaan Baptist
20	Church with his family; as an adult, he became a member of the
21	historic Star of Zion A.M.E. Zion Church, where he served as
22	church treasurer, steward, and secretary of the Board of
23	Trustees; after the close of Star of Zion, Dr. Franklin became
24	a member of Kelly Springs Missionary Baptist Church and
25	remained a member until his passing; and
26	WHEREAS, Dr. Franklin attended Westside School in
27	Talladega; he enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1951,

where he actively served until 1955; he then became a reservist until 1958; and

WHEREAS, in 1962, he graduated from Alabama State

University with a degree in Government and Psychology; on

January 4, 1964, Dr. Franklin became the first African

American to attend Auburn University, but due to adversity he
was unable to defend his thesis; he furthered his studies at

Brandeis University, Pine Manor Junior College, the University
of Denver, and Tufts University; he earned his Master's Degree
from Auburn University in the Spring of 2020; and

WHEREAS, professionally, Dr. Franklin served as a professor at the University of Denver, Alabama State
University, North Carolina A and T University, Tuskegee
University, and Talladega College; in 1992, he retired from higher education and became a fulltime employee with Terry's
Metropolitan Mortuary; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Franklin was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Mrs. Lilla M. Franklin; parents; twin brother, Harry Alphonso Franklin; siblings, George Franklin, Jr., John Henry Franklin, Mary Anna Dickerson, Spencer Robert Franklin, and Alice Ruth Ragland; and

WHEREAS, survivors include his son, Harold Franklin, Jr.; grandson, Deldrick Franklin; sisters, Pauline Smiley, Edwina White, and Yvette Franklin; sister-in-law, Audrey M. Butts; and a host of other relatives and friends; and

WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly 1 2 missed, the memory of Dr. Franklin will be cherished in the 3 hearts of all who knew and loved him; now therefore, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 4 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the death of Dr. Harold A. 5 Franklin is recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution is 6 offered in tribute to his life and with heartfelt sympathy to 7 his family, whose grief is shared by many. 8
