11 death on February 25, 2017, of Mr. Zodie McCall of Helena,  
12 Alabama, at the age 80 years; and

13 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of

17 siblings and graduated from Wenonah High School; and

21 County when he was hired by the Helena Police Department; and

22 WHEREAS, during his career, he was a convenience  
23 store owner, served 29 years with the Shelby County Board of  
24 Education as a bus driver, and worked at the local Winn Dixie;

26 WHEREAS, Mr. McCall was a devout Christian and  
27 faithful member of Kingwood Church, Alabaster, Alabama; and

1                   WHEREAS, survivors include his devoted wife, Amelia  
2 Hampton McCall; children, Sam Paige, Winfred McCall (Angel),  
3 Demetria Billings (David), Sharon Murph (David), Lakesha Pate,  
4 and Deon Taylor (Ardie); step-daughter, Terri Hampton;  
5 siblings, Jim and Susie Taylor; Dave, Algeray, and Anthony  
6 McCall; Dovie White; Barbara and Maxine Young; Clevann  
7 Blackstone; Gwen Battle; and Leona Lawrence; and
