6 Wise; nieces Jayme Braaton (Mark Wilson), and Lori (Mark)
7 Hadley; and a host of relatives, and friends; and

9 by many, we join with others to celebrate his life and to
10 mourn his death; although his presence will be greatly missed,
11 his memory will be cherished in the hearts and minds of those
