Waldrop faithfully and honorably served the state and 17 the University of South Alabama during a seven-year 18 presidency; and WHEREAS, Dr. Waldrop was named as the third 19 president of the University of South Alabama on February 2, 20 21 2014; and 22 WHEREAS, Dr. Waldrop organized the University of South Alabama's future around five priorities for success; 23 24 student access and success, enhancement of research and graduate education, excellence in health care, global 25 26 engagement, and University-Community engagement; the

WHEREAS, Dr. Waldrop streamlined international initiatives under Global USA and increased the number of students participating in study abroad programs, expanding educational opportunities, and preparing students for a global workforce; and

18 WHEREAS, the University of South Alabama, under Dr. 19 Waldrop's leadership, has responded to business and industry 20 needs by adding graduate programs and, in 2020, grew its 21 research awards to more than \$100 million; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Waldrop oversaw a significant expansion 23 of USA Health, which, during his presidency, added dozens of 24 new physicians and practices to its roster of providers, 25 expanding and improving options for patients across Coastal 26 Alabama; and 1 WHEREAS, Dr. Waldrop and his wife, Dr. Julee 2 Waldrop, have played active civic roles in South Alabama, and 3 have encouraged the University of South Alabama community to 4 do the same, including through the creation of the Office of 5 Community Involvement; and
