8 RECOGNIZING ALABAMA YOM HASHOAH COMMEMORATION ON
9 APRIL 30, 2019.

11 WHEREAS, the Alabama Holocaust Commission will hold
12 its 2019 State Yom HaShoah Commemoration on Tuesday, April 30,
13 2019, at the State Capitol in Montgomery, Alabama; and speaker
14 for the event will be Governor Kay Ivey, and attending
15 Holocaust survivors and Second Generation members will be
16 introduced; and

17 WHEREAS, Yom HaShoah was instituted in Israel in
18 1951 as a day of commemoration for the six million Jews who
19 perished in the Holocaust; and

20 WHEREAS, there is no institutionalized ritual for
21 Yom HaShoah; commemorations may include synagogue services,
22 communal vigils, and educational programs; lighting memorial
23 candles and reciting prayers for the departed are generally
24 part of the solemn ceremony; and

25 WHEREAS, the Alabama Holocaust Commission was
26 established by legislation in 1999 to foster understanding and
27 promote education about the Holocaust; our good friend and

1 colleague, Representative David Faulkner of Jefferson County
2 is an active member of this commission; and

3 WHEREAS, among the duties of the Alabama Holocaust
4 Commission is the responsibility to enhance public awareness
5 of the consequences and significance of the Holocaust; the
6 enabling act of the Commission states that it is the policy of
7 the State of Alabama that Holocaust education is the proper
8 concern of all peoples; and

9 WHEREAS, events such as the 2019 Yom HaShoah
10 Commemoration are consistent with the mission of the Alabama
11 Holocaust Commission providing Holocaust education and
12 focusing on citizen involvement in this commemoration; now
13 therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
15 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That on this momentous occasion of
16 the Yom HaShoah Commemoration sponsored by the Alabama
17 Holocaust Commission on April 30, 2019, we recognize and honor
18 the memory of the lives lost in the Holocaust, and by copy of
19 this resolution prepared for appropriate presentation and
20 display, we recognize this solemn occasion as one to enhance
21 public awareness of the consequences and significance of the
22 Holocaust.
