12 J. T. Johnson of Monroeville, Alabama, for his outstanding
13 professional service; a Troy, Alabama native, Mr. Johnson
14 graduated from Huntingdon College in 1994 and moved to
15 Monroeville in 1995; and

16 WHEREAS, due to his passion for the citizens of
17 Monroeville, Mr. Johnson has been an excellent public servant;
18 he began volunteering with the Monroe County Emergency
19 Management Agency (MCEMA) in the late 1990s and through the
20 years, has been involved in numerous ways; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson served as volunteer deputy
22 director, public information officer, and communications
23 officer, before becoming Director of MCEMA in 2011; he was
24 involved in the response to Hurricanes Ivan and Katrina, has
25 maintained the county's communication systems, and has been a
26 part of the Alabama Strategic Technology Reserve; and

2 Johnson is an advanced level emergency manager, is a Federal
3 Communications Commission licensed amateur extra class radio
4 operator, a Ham Radio operator, and a SkyWarn weather spotter;

7 First Responders Wireless Commission by Governor Robert
8 Bentley, and has served on the Alabama Association of
9 Emergency Managers Technology Committee; leading by example,
