23	WHEREAS, the highly heralded Hueytown, Alabama,
24	resident and NASCAR racer Red Farmer is a one-of-a-kind sports

27	Nashville, Tennessee, Red began racing in 1948, the same year

that NASCAR was formed; he moved to Florida at 15 years of
age; in 1949, he won his first race in Opa-Locka, Florida; he
and his family moved to Hueytown, Alabama, in 1962; he is a
founding member of the infamous racing Alabama Gang, which
included legends Bobby Allison and Donnie Allison; his
signature race car was named F 97 and was painted white and
gold; and

WHEREAS, like Red Farmer's mind-boggling career, he has had the same sponsor every year since 1962, Long-Lewis Ford, an Alabama automotive dealership founded in 1915; even more impressive, is that all 60 years of that sponsorship deal were done - and continue to be done - on strictly a handshake-only basis; and

WHEREAS, through the years, Red Farmer has earned widespread admiration and respect for his tireless dedication and exceptional racing abilities; he has piled up more than 750 race victories and has held a NASCAR competition license continuously since 1953, an unprecedented streak; he is a four time NASCAR National Champion; in 1956, he won the Modified National Championship; he won three consecutive Grand National Division Championships in 1969, 1970, and 1971; in the NASCAR ARCA series Red Farmer won Daytona in 1971 and Talledega in 1984 and 1988, a special victory because his friend, Davey Allison, Bobby Allison's son, served as his crew chief for the 1988 race; and

WHEREAS, Red Farmer is a member of 10 Hall of Fames including, Alabama Sports Hall of Fame, Talladega-Texaco Walk

of Fame, Dirt Track Hall of Fame, International Motorsports 1 2 Hall of Fame, Daytona Beach Stock Car Hall of Fame, Jacksonville Hall of Fame, Living Legends of Auto Racing Hall 3 of Fame, Alabama Auto Racing Pioneers, National Motorsports 4 5 Press Association Hall of Fame, and last, but certainly not least, the cherry on top, NASCAR Hall of Fame; his very good 7 friend, Tony Stewart was the presenter of the special NASCAR Hall of Fame ring; his honors include the Governor of Alabama 9 Award by the International Motorsports Hall of 1999, Team 10 consultant for M.L. Motorsports of Warsaw, Indiana, and Governor's Award for the Alabama Gang and the Racing Angels; 11 12 his monumental accomplishments reflect immense credit upon 13 NASCAR and the entire State of Alabama, and he is deserving of special commendation and praise; now therefore, 14
