WHEREAS, an on-going campaign by providers to inform consumers about the harm inflicted, particularly to minors, and how to filter or block harmful and inappropriate material would be a beneficial public service; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we urge providers in the technology industry to inform the general public regarding the easy access of inappropriate material available on the Internet and to educate adults on methods to filter or block the transfer of inappropriate material on devices available for use by minors.
